RULES & REGULATIONS

Benefits of membership: Eligible for Year-End Awards, Ride All Day Discounted Fees (includes high point fee), Vote in Club decisions, Receive a permanent back number and the ability to preregister for shows. Membership is \$25.00 for individual and \$40.00 per family. **All non-member riders will pay a daily \$5.00 high point fee.**

High Point is one horse, one rider, per division, per age group (except Adult Walk-Trot). Daily High Point is counted from the time your membership or the daily \$5.00 fee is paid. All age division classes count towards Daily High Point unless otherwise noted.

High Point System (regardless of number of entries):

1 st Place: 6 Points	2 nd Place: 5 Points	3 rd Place: 4 Points
4 th Place: 3 Points	5 th Place: 2 Points	6 th Place: 1 Point

Year End Awards are tabulated for each class, excluding Sweepstakes. You **MUST** be a member and show at least 3 of the 5 shows to qualify for Year-End Awards. Year End Points will not be counted until your membership is paid. Year End Points are counted separately for each horse/rider combination shown and will not be combined. **Year End Awards are given out for Champion, Reserve and Honorable Mention.**

Middle/High School Equestrian Team Award – Rider(s) will earn points for their team. Daily Team Points accrue and count for all team members present and competing. The same rider(s) do **NOT** have to compete at each event. Rider(s) will also accrue daily high points, if the rider is a member or pays the daily fee. Rider(s) **MUST** identify their team and specify High School or Middle School on their entry form. Team points for current and upcoming team riders only. SPUR of the Moment Horse Club will not be responsible for tracing a rider's team membership.

Hobby Horse Rookie Rewards Horsemanship – www.hobbyhorseinc.com/rookie_rewards for full details. This class is for any exhibitor of any age that has never won a blue ribbon in any class (except leadline) at any show. Class will be shown at walk and trot only. There will be rail work one direction and a horsemanship pattern. \$100 Hobby Horse gift certificate for 1st place, ribbons through 5th place.

Hunter Hack will consist of two fences plus a single direction shown on the rail, walk, trot, and canter. Specific pattern will be posted at the show. In Cross Rails, trotting over jumps is permitted, canter still required for rail work portion of the class. You may enter only 1 hunter hack class. Schooling fence will be available.

All 4-H rules apply, regardless of rider's age, except where otherwise noted. Honesty and Sportsmanship are expected of all participants and spectators. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on show grounds. SPUR of the Moment asks that you clean up around your area before you leave the grounds.

Proper attire is required for all classes with the exception of speed events. Requirements for speed classes include long pants, a shirt with a minimum of a 4-inch sleeve, and boots with a minimum ½-inch heel. **SPUR requires helmets be worn by riders 18 years and under. Speed riders that compete in Trail can compete in speed attire without penalty provided they follow the above clothing requirements. Speed horses in speed bits and speed tack are allowed to compete in Trail without penalty.** Hitting the entrance gate or fences with the horse during the speed events will be cause for disqualification from that class. Polo wraps on horses are not allowed during Speed events. **Speed Events will not commence before 2:00 p.m. at any show, feel free to call an officer to check actual start times.**

ANSI or SEI helmets are recommended; hunt caps are allowed in the appropriate Hunt Seat classes.

Jr. Horse age is 5 & under, Sr Horse age is 6 & over, as of **12/31/2012**.

Rider age is determined as of **1/01/2012**. You must ride in your own age group, no crossovers will be allowed.

SPUR of the Moment reserves the right to cancel, split, or combine classes at any time for any reason. Sign-up for desired classes must be done **TWO** full classes in advance. Sign up for the Halter classes must be completed 10 minutes before the show starts. When the gate is closed, the class has started. It is the rider's responsibility to be ready for their class.

Judges' decisions are **final**. Participants and spectators, when outside the ring may have no contact with the judge. All complaints must be made in writing to the Board of Officers for review. **Absolutely no refunds will be issued.** Classes cancelled due to inclement weather will not be rescheduled or refunded. **In the event of a cancelled event, there will be NO double pointing of classes at subsequent events.**

SPUR of the Moment Horse Club and Woodbine Farms will not be responsible for death, accident, injury, or theft of any kind, to anyone or anything. Horse owner is responsible for all actions and damages done by their horse(s).

Under the Michigan Equine Activity Liability Act (enrolled House Bill #5006, enacted 1994), an equine event sponsor is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in an equine activity resulting from inherent risk of the equine activity.
