## RULES & REGULATIONS

**Benefits of membership:** Eligible for Year-End Awards, \$35.00 to show all day (includes high point fee), Vote in Club decisions. Membership is \$25.00 for individual and \$40.00 per family. **All non-member riders will pay a daily \$5.00 grounds fee.**

**High Point is one horse, one rider, per division, per age group.** Daily High Point is counted from the time your membership or the daily \$5.00 fee is paid. All classes count toward Daily High Point unless otherwise noted.

### High Point System (regardless of number of entries):

1 <sup>st</sup> Place: 6 Points	2 <sup>nd</sup> Place: 5 Points	3 <sup>rd</sup> Place: 4 Points
4 <sup>th</sup> Place: 3 Points	5 <sup>th</sup> Place: 2 Points	6 <sup>th</sup> Place: 1 Point

Daily High-Points tabulated for each class, excluding Sweepstakes, Novice, and OPEN.

**Hobby Horse Rookie Rewards Horsemanship** – [www.hobbyhorseinc.com/rookie\\_rewards](http://www.hobbyhorseinc.com/rookie_rewards) for full details. This class is for any exhibitor of any age that has not won more than **3** blue ribbons in any riding class (except leadline) at any show. Class will be shown at walk and trot only. There will be rail work one direction and a horsemanship pattern. \$100 Hobby Horse gift certificate for 1<sup>st</sup> place, ribbons through 5<sup>th</sup> place.

All 4-H rules apply, regardless of rider's age, except where otherwise noted. God's name is to be honored. Honesty and Sportsmanship are expected of all participants and spectators. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on fairgrounds. SPUR of the Moment asks that you clean up around your area before you leave the grounds.

Proper attire is required for all classes with the exception Speed events. Requirements for these classes include long pants, a shirt with a minimum of a 4-inch sleeve, and boots with a minimum ½-inch heel. ANSI or SEI helmets are recommended; hunt caps are allowed in the appropriate Hunt Seat classes. Speed will follow all other 4-H rules and regulations. **SPUR requires helmets be worn by riders 19 years and under while riding on the grounds and in the make-up area. Speed riders that compete in Trail can compete in speed attire without penalty provided they follow the above clothing requirements. Speed horses in speed bits and speed tack are allowed to compete in Trail without penalty.**

Hitting the entrance gate with the horse during Speed events will be cause for disqualification from that class. Polo wraps on horses are not allowed during Speed events. **Speed Events will not commence before 3:00 p.m. on any show date.**

Horse owner is responsible for all actions and damages done by their horse(s).

Jr. Horse age is 5 & under as of 12/31 current year.

SPUR of the Moment reserves the right to cancel, split, or combine classes at any time. Sign-up for desired classes must be done **TWO** full classes in advance. When the gate is closed, the class has started. It is the rider's responsibility to be ready for their class.

Rider age is determined as of **1/01/2009**. You must ride in your own age group, no crossovers will be allowed.

Judges' decisions are **final**. Participants and spectators, when outside the ring may have no contact with the judge. All complaints must be made in writing to the Board of Officers for review. **Absolutely no refunds will be issued.** Classes cancelled due to inclement weather will not be rescheduled or refunded. **In the event of a cancelled event, there will be NO double pointing of classes at subsequent events.**

SPUR of the Moment Horse Club will not be responsible for death, accident, injury, or theft of any kind, to anyone or anything.
